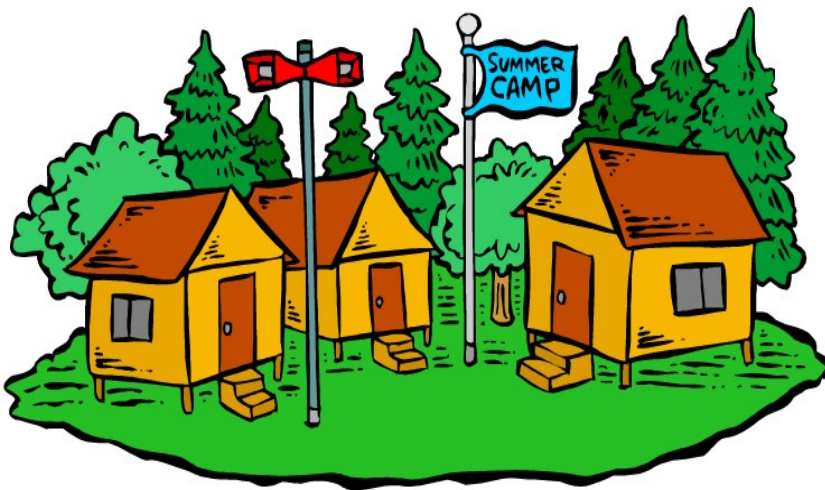

**INFORMATION** — (Please keep this side of the brochure for your information.)

**WHEN** - July 22–July 25, 2017 (coming out of 3rd –5th grades); July 24–July 25 (coming out of 1st-2nd grades).

(Third through Sixth graders will leave from the church at 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, July 22, and will return to the church on Tuesday, July 25 at 11:00 AM. First and Second graders will leave from the church at 1:30 PM on Monday, July 24 and return to the church on Tuesday, July 25 at 11:00 AM.)

**WHO** - Kids' Kamp is for all boys and girls of Oakland Baptist Church and their guests coming out of grades 1-5. **ALL CAMPERS MUST HAVE COMPLETED First Grade.** Parents are welcome to visit, but must abide by the same rules as the campers.

**HOW MUCH** - The total cost is \$120 for 3rd-6th graders and \$60 for 1st-2nd graders. Cost for second child is \$10 off original price. This includes lodging, meals, snack ticket and a camp t-shirt. **A \$20 non-refundable deposit should be turned in with this application no later than Sunday, July 9. (This is to give time to order T-shirts)( Balance due by July 16th)**

### WHAT TO BRING TO KIDS' KAMP

1. Linens (sheets, blanket, pillow, and/or sleeping bag)
2. Flashlight
3. Bathing suit (modest please; one piece preferred)
4. Towels and wash cloths
5. Personal hygiene articles (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, etc.)
6. Clothing for three days (no dress clothes)
7. Plastic bag(s) for dirty and wet clothing
8. Bible, pencil/pen, and notebook

### DO NOT BRING:

Radios, televisions, water guns, fireworks, shaving cream, or a bad attitude

**DO NOT** : Play any jokes or pranks on anyone or any cabin.

**DO NOT:** Play fight or rough house with each other.
